Ziegler France lays the foundation stone for its future multimodal branch in Dunkerque : a strategic project to strengthen sustainable logistics and international trade

Dunkerque, 26 February 2025

A ceremony that opens a new chapter for the Ziegler Group

On February 26, 2025, a foundation stone ceremony marked the beginning of a major project for Ziegler France. The event was attended by:

- Mr. Alain Ziegler, Chairman of the Ziegler Group
- Mr. Patrice Vergriete, Former Minister, Mayor of Dunkerque, and Chairman of the Urban Community
- Mr. Maurice Georges, Chairman of the Management Board of Dunkerque-Port
- Numerous partners and key economic stakeholders

This new logistics hub, strategically located in the Port of Dunkerque, demonstrates Ziegler's commitment to high-performance, sustainable, and connected logistics solutions.

An ambitious project for smart and sustainable logistics

Located in the heart of France's 3rd largest port, this future multimodal branch will cover 55,000 sq.m. and will comprise a building of over 19,400 sq.m., including:

- A 16,750 m² logistics warehouse,
- A 2,000 m² domestic groupage,
- 400 m² of RE2020-compliant offices.

In the branch will be equipped with 40 loading docks, 2 access ramps, and 4 freight dock accesses, along with 46 HGV parking spaces and 42 car parking spaces. Additionally, it will feature a 280 ml rail connection, enhancing multimodal transport capabilities.

Designed to meet the latest sustainable logistics challenges, the site will hold a BREEAM 'Very Good' environmental certification and incorporate a secure lithium battery storage system. Its environmentally friendly infrastructure will include electric vehicle charging stations and photovoltaic panels with a capacity of 965 kWp.With ICPE 1510E certification, the facility will optimize energy efficiency through a range of sustainable features, including rainwater recovery systems, LED lighting, and reversible cassette heating and air conditioning for office spaces.

A strategic partnership with the Dunkerque -Port

This project reinforces Ziegler's collaboration with Dunkerque-Port, working together to develop a modern, multimodal logistics hub. Their shared goal is to enhance the region's attractiveness by providing integrated, competitive, and environmentally friendly supply chain solutions.

Patrice VERGRIETE, Former Minister, Mayor of Dunkerque and Chairman of the Dunkerque Urban Community: 'We are proud that Ziegler France, a major player in transport and logistics, is coming to our region. This project blends innovation and environmental responsibility, will help to diversify the local economy, will create jobs and offer new prospects for local businesses, while meeting the energy and environmental challenges of the future. '

Maurice GEORGES, Chairman of the Management Board of Dunkerque-Port: «With this new facility, the Ziegler Group is contributing to strengthening Dunkerque's position as a leading logistics hub in Northern Europe. Ideally located at the heart of the port ecosystem, within the new Dunkerque Logistique International (DLI) zone, this building, with its rail connection, will play a strategic role in the development of port and industrial activities».

Scheduled to open in 2026

The branch is set to open in the first quarter of 2026, further solidifying its role as a key logistics hub. It will enhance connections between Europe and Asia while driving economic growth through its modern, high-performance infrastructure.
